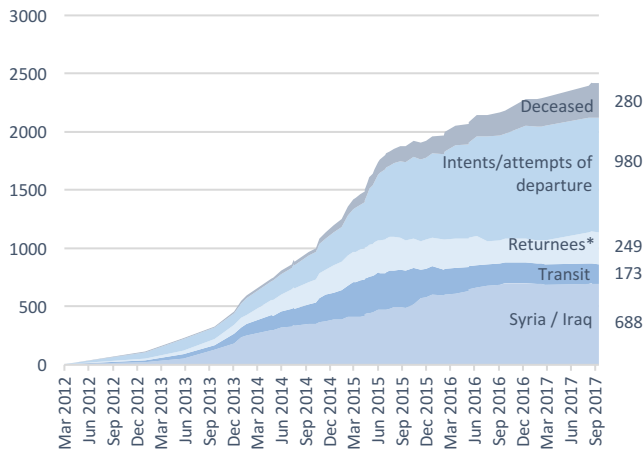


European Jihad Watch – n° 4 – November 2017

- More than 2300 French nationals or residents have been involved in Syrian-Iraqi jihadist networks (including 688 in Syria or Iraq).
- 465 legal proceedings concerning 1469 individuals are ongoing.
- Almost 7500 Europeans nationals or residents have been involved in Syrian-Iraqi jihadist networks.
- As of November 2017, there have been more terrorist attacks in the EU in 2017 than in the whole of 2016.

*Since July 2016, only the individuals who entered the area of terrorist operations in Syria-Iraq are categorized as returnees. Beforehand, this segment also included individuals arrested abroad before entering the area. These are now included in the segment of intents/attempts of departure.

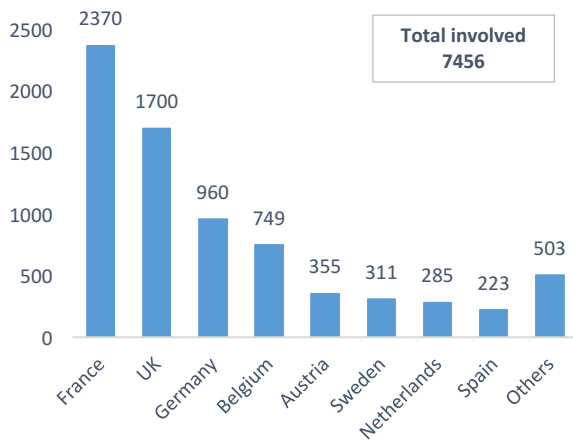

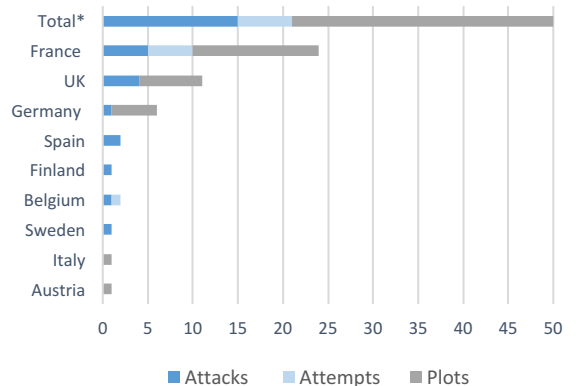
